




FIG. 1-FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE




FIG. 2- MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE SURGE




FIG. 3-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS




FIG. 4-TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS
